A modern and very metropolitan city, Bogotá highlights both its past and present and proudly features soaring colonia and neo-gothic churches, a Bohemian arts scene, high-end shopping to die for, and views from the cliffs above this city of over 7 ½ million people

Community OUTing: HISTORIC BOGOTÁ CITY TOUR

You'll begin your tour this morning when your local, bilingual tour guide meets you at your hotel for a tour of the most historic parts of Bogotá. You'll soon see why Colombia's largest city is one of Latin America's premier capitals of art and culture. Note that your tour is fully customizable as far as length and sites. You can even change the order of sites or add more while the tour is in progress. We also offer an "Express" option – without lunch – if you are short on time.

Dominating the city center, el Cerro de Monserrate is a mountain rising 10,341 feet above sea level. You'll be taking a cable car/trolley up the steep mountainside to enjoy the most spectacular views of Bogotá once you reach the summit. Along with outstanding views is an historic village featuring a 17th century shrine. There are vendors selling all kinds of artisanal crafts and traditional foods to snack on if you get hungry. If you like, we'll help you arrange the timing to enjoy an exquisite sunset view from atop Monserrate..

Other features of this tour include a walk through the city center to explore La Candelaria, Colombia's oldest neighborhood. Along the way, try some chicha, a traditional Colombian street drink made from fermented fruit rinds. This historic neighborhood is also home to a university district, full of cobblestoned streets and centuries-old houses.

Stop by the Plaza de Bolivar, an historic colonial square where Colombia's government is located: there you will find the Congress, the Cathedral, the Palace of Justice, the Palacio Liévano (Mayor's Office) and the House of the 20th of July. If you're feeling up to it, you may want to end the day at the spectacular Museo del Oro (Gold Museum), featuring the world's biggest collection of pre-Columbian gold and other metals. Other options include visits to the Centro Cultural Gabriel García Márquez, the Museo Botero, the Observatorio Astronómico, or any of our many impressive museums, galleries, and sites of interest.

Think you know coffee? Here in Colombia, it's more than just a quick pick-me up to get you through the day. It's part of social interaction, our workplace life, and is likely what the world knows most of Colombian cultural identity. Colombia's coffee plantations are the largest exporter of Arabica beans globally, so we like to think we bring a little bit of Colombia into homes around the world.

Have your Coffee Baptism at a "Temple of Coffee" owned by Colombia's most awarded coffee plantation. We will pick you up at your hotel and bring you to this Temple where you'll have your opportunity to appreciate the many nuances of coffee in much the same manner as wine-tasting. In fact, the brothers who now run the plantation are the 3rd generation of this family-owned business were inspired to develop these experiences as they toured and tasted their way through the vineyards of France. Your coffee baptism is designed to awaken all your senses.

First, you'll learn about coffee production here in Colombia, what is involved in harvesting and processing this glorious crop. Next comes how to appreciate all of coffee's "organoleptic" qualities: scent, taste, mouth feel and more, no different than testing fine cognacs. Now for your sensorial awakening as you begin to discern distinct aromas and flavors. Hone your new talents now with cuppings of 3 different coffees from their plantation.

PICNIC LUNCH AT THE CASTLE MUSEUM

We'll pick you up from your hotel in private transportation and take you to the Museo El Castillo (Castle Museum). Inspired by the castles in France's Loire Valley, it was built in 1930 by the city's first architecture firm as a residence and remains a jewel of Medellín's architecture. In 1971, the building became a museum.

Enjoy a picnic lunch with your concierge/guide and an invited guest from the local LGBTQ community. You'll be sitting among the castle's exquisite gardens with gorgeous views of the Aburrá Valley below. The museum itself happily caters your picnic, providing the food, basket, blanket, flatware, plates glasses and offer 5 different meal options to select from, accompanied by wine or juices.

If you wish, it is possible to tour the inside of the museum. El Castillo is a non-profit, promoting arts & culture. It curates a collection of works by Colombian and European masters, as well as some exhibits of furniture and decorative arts. Most of the rooms have been maintained as they were when the Castillo was a residence, with their original furniture.

MEDELLÍN

Community OUTing: MEDELLÍN TRANSFORMATION TOUR

We'll pick you up and head over to the city's civic center where we'll begin an exploration of Medellín and its history, starting from the industrial revolution to the dark days of the 80's and 90's. This tour focuses on the importance of architecture and transit here and the roles they -- as well as the LGBTQ community -- have played in transforming Medellín into one of the world's most promising and innovative cities.

You'll walk through the brilliant Parque de las Luces and Parque Berrio/Plaza Botero, and visit the Museum of Antioquia, which is full of sculptures, paintings, and drawings donated by Botero to his home city. As you continue, you'll be able to browse traditional handicrafts and souvenirs at a local market, and pass flower-lined streets and parks. Before enjoying a traditional lunch at a local restaurant, you'll have the option to visit the government-funded LGBTQ community center for a quick tour of the facility, if available.

In the afternoon, you'll get to know Medellín's violent past, understand its bright present and promising future as you tour the infamous Comuna 13. This was the most dangerous barrio in what was then the most dangerous city in the world. There you'll interact with the community, learn how community members used graffiti to tell their stories, and witness firsthand how public projects, like the electronic escalators on the mountainside, helped transform the neighborhood.

There is an option for a longer, 8-hour tour, which can include a visit to the House of Memory Museum, which recognizes the victims of the city's armed conflict of the last 50 years. Be sure to ask about this impactful option!

At the finca you'll learn the entire process of making coffee, from the plant to the cup. You'll also get an understanding of daily life on Colombian coffee cooperatives still producing coffee in a traditional and fair way.

The coffee finca you'll visit is very typical of many small family-run businesses in Colombia who produce an exclusive coffee that, of course, you will get to taste. Just as importantly, you'll learn to brew the perfect cup at home and even have an opportunity to purchase straight from the source. After an educational hands-on experience during a tour of the grounds, you'll enjoy a traditional lunch made with love.

CARTAGENA

Get ready to escape to paradise as you head to the hot, Caribbean coast! Although founded in 1533 by the Spaniards, the history of this area dates back to 4,000 BCE. Cartagena once played a central role in Spain's political and economic activity in the New World. Today, Cartagena is the most popular tourist destination in Colombia and was declared a UNESCO World Heritage Site in 1984.

Cartagena is known as a very warm city with average year-round temperatures of 88 degrees Fahrenheit, lows of 75 derees, 90% humidity, with beautiful breezes rolling in from the Caribbean Sea.

To book this package, **a nonrefundable deposit of \$1,150 USD per person is due at the time of booking.** The remainder of the balance is due 60 days before the start of the trip and is 100% refundable if cancelled at least 30 days before the first day in the itinerary. If you book within 60 days of the first travel date, then payment-in-full is required to book the reservation, of which \$1,150 USD per person will be considered non-refundable, and the remaining balance will be 100% refundable if cancelled at least 30 days before the first day in the itinerary. We can only confirm the reservation once the initial deposit is received.
